Makes your mouth water for some new equipment, and antennas WOW!

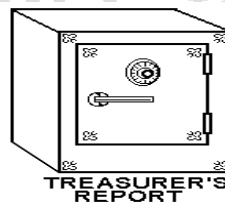
I did take some pictures and I will try and get them to our editor next month so they can be included in the November letter, and will send them, to N3NVA for the web site .

1.
