The classes will assist potential hams pass the Technician and General License Grade FCC exams.

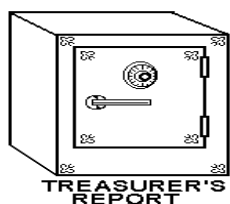
As in the past, Chris/NU3L, George/N3SQD, and AI/W3CE will be the instructors.

New Call for Mel Snyder, W3PYF

My father Clarence Snyder died July 20, 2005.

Thanks to all who made his more than 60 years as a ham so happy. On January 10, 2006, the FCC granted my request to honor my father's memory by exchanging my call of 36 years, W2FLO, for his.

Dad received just about every service award a ham can earn, thanks to his more than 50 years as radio officer of Northampton (PA) County. He was inducted into the Clara Barton Society of the American Red Cross for his service during many disasters, most notably the 1955 Hurricane Diane flood that devastated the area of the forks of the Delaware and Lehigh rivers. He was a prizewinning photographer for his beloved Bethlehem Steel for more than 40 years, and earned the coveted Masters certification of the Professional Photographers of America. He "Elmer'd" more new hams than he could recall.

Dad was a mainstay on 3999 for decades; I, on the other hand, have been almost exclusively CW since I got my first license in 1957. I hope to see you on the air with his treasured call in the future.

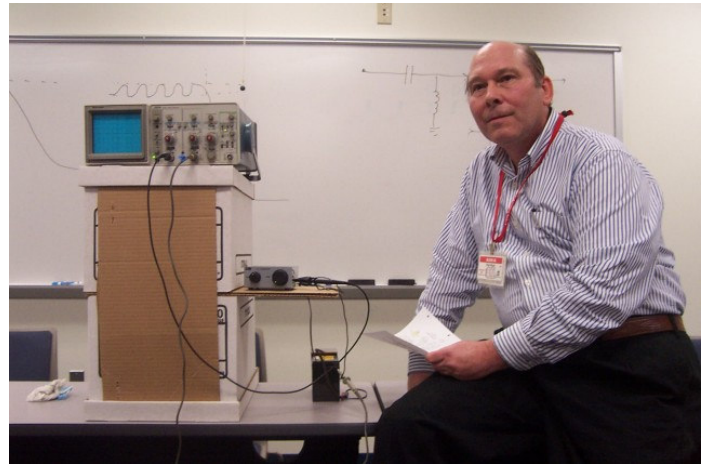

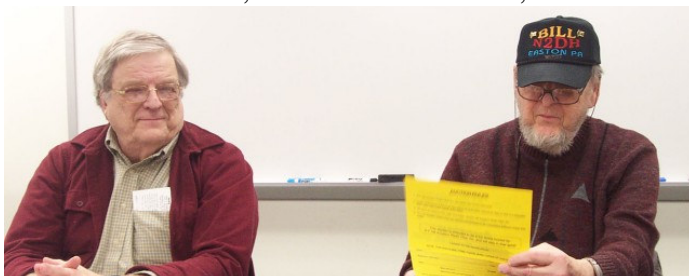

The DLARC forum

The DLARC forum is a club sponsored mailing list (email reflector) that is used to keep club members informed on upcoming events, send general announcements, relay information on weather or emergency situations and drills, and pass along any other information on club activities. It is also intended as an open forum for all club members to use to discuss club issues, general ham radio related topics, or tap the wealth of knowledge and experience of the membership at large.

All club members are welcome to subscribe. To join go to this URL:
<http://mailman.qth.net/mailman/listinfo/dlarcforum>
 and fill in the information. After you fill in the web form your information is sent to the list administrator for verification. Your identity and membership in DLARC will be verified since this is a closed list and is limited to DLARC members only. That means that you will not get any spam or junk mail from the reflector.

Please remember that you can only post a message using the email account that you used to subscribe to the list. If you try to post a message from another account (your work email, etc.) it will be rejected by the system because that account is not subscribed. You can subscribe to the DLARC forum with more

than one account if you want to be able to post from various accounts/locations.

Note: If you subscribe to the DLARC forum using an arrl.net account you will only be able to receive messages. You will not be able to post a message because you cannot send messages from arrl.net due to the fact that it is an email forwarding service only.

The mailman.qth.net webpage has links to help you with any questions you might have regarding subscribing and using a reflector. You will also receive instructions along with your welcome message when you subscribe. If you have additional questions please contact the list administrator.
